Thomas F. McDermott has more than 35 years of industry experience in the fields of Accounting, Contracting, Estimating and Cost Control. Mr. McDermott has held a variety of positions in Finance, Procurement, Operations, Customer Service, and Systems. He has utilized strategic cost control techniques to develop effective and successful tools to insure corporate profitability in an increasingly demanding corporate environment. His extensive experience base in the areas of Price Negotiation, Cost Estimating, Forecasting and Analysis combined with superior leadership and interpersonal skills have Mr. McDermott a significant contributor throughout a distinguished career. Some examples of his contributions and accomplishments are as follows

- Contributed several ACE teams for insuring ACE Gold for P&W Military Finance.
- Successfully lead negotiation teams that defined engine and spare part prices for procurements in excess \$500m of annually.

- Supported and justified subcontractor cost estimates throughout the government negotiation process. This included the support of sole sourced subcontractor data and long term agreements formed with our supplier base. This required an intimate knowledge of should cost techniques used to determine final price justification. Support of subcontractor pricing and contract terms and conditions that effect price determination was key in successful negotiation of price.

Thomas was employed by Pratt & Whitney for 33 years enjoying a successful career that evidenced significant contributions in the Financial Discipline with a focus in cost estimating, accounting, controls, contracting and system development.
